The following budget amendment has been approved to incorporate the additional funds:

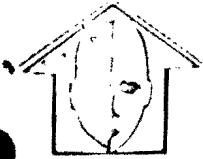

Dear Ms. Tyler,

I have obtained further clarification concerning the sprinkler system required by the State Fire Code for our new permanent shelter facility at 1114 7th Street, Parkersburg. A more competitive bid was submitted by Grenelle from Clarksburg, estimating the price for the system at \$19,000.00. The Contractor, Partitions, Inc., has accepted this bid, the lowest bid placed by a reputable company. I have been assured that the Contract with this company can be signed no later than September 30, 1982. Our contractor states they will have the sprinkler system installed and operational before December 31, 1982. I am providing this information to your agency to confirm that these requirements can be met if awarded the supplemental LEAA funds.

Pursuant to LEAA grant requirements for projects such as this, The Coalition has the required match monies in cash. I hope this information assists you in preparation for the meeting scheduled August 27th, 1982 in Charleston. I appreciate your assistance with this project.
