

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held September 28, 1982

PRESENT: President, Holmes R. Shaver
Commissioner, William C. Parrish
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

Upon the motion of Commissioner William C. Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver, it is hereby ORDERED that the FEES for keeping and maintaining Prisoners in the WOOD COUNTY CORRECTIONAL CENTER (JAIL) for the months of October, November and December, 1982 will be (\$19.50) per prisoner day.

It is further ORDERED that the appropriate municipalities Agencies and Authorities be notified by forwarding them a Copy of this ORDER.

This ORDER excludes keeping of FEDERAL Prisoners, by reason of Separate Contract.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission met with Ms. Linda Brohard, Ms. Barbara Grady, and Mr. Bob Nutter representatives from the Consumer Advisory Group. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss various types of handicapped persons in the area, and the accessibility to various buildings in the area. Ms. Brohard pointed out to the Commission that January 1st was the kick-off date for the "Access West Virginia Campaign" sponsored by the handicapped. The campaign will help to access the needs of the handicapped. Commissioner Shaver pointed out and assured the group that the Courthouse Judicial Annex will be constructed to meet the needs of the handicapped. Mr. Shaver pointed out and apologized in regard to the present Court House, but went on to say that they

were waiting until the Court House had been completely renovated before steps were taken to correct the problem of not having the facilities needed and required for the handicapped.

Also, at a brief meeting with the Commission and Mr. Bob Morgan, Mr. Morgan met to urge the Commission to have the Board of Education use the Prosecuting Attorney as Legal Council instead of obtaining outside legal council. The Commission told Mr. Morgan that they would check into the matter.

Also, Mr. Edwin L. D. Dils and Mrs. Virginia representatives from the Wood County Commission on Crime Delinquency and Correction met with the Commission to request \$6,100.00 from Revenue Sharing Entitlement #14 funds for various administrative costs and expenditures. The Commission stated that they would put the request on file for consideration.

Mr. Benjamin McDay also met before the Commission as a representative from the Big Brothers - Big Sisters of Parkersburg, to request \$2,000.00 for Administrative Costs. The Commission pointed out to Mr. McDay that they would file his request along with the others for their consideration.

Also, on this the 28th day of September, 1982 the County Commission received bids and quotations upon advertisement to bid to install & complete all electrical work(s) and improvements in the Wood County Court House. The following bids and quotations were received; Pickering Electric, \$697,000.00, McHenry Electric, \$275,604.00, and Northwest Electric, /\$348,000.00. Upon the motion of Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., and made unanimous by Commissioner William C. Parrish, it was ORDERED that the aforementioned bids be taken under advisement, with disposition to be made at a later session of this Commission. A copy of this ORDER is in attachment.






