

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held April 19th, 1983

Present: President, William C. Parrish

Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

Upon advertisement to bid for the water storage project in the Lubeck Public Service District, the Commission received two (2) bids, the first from Larry M. McDaniel, Inc., in the amount of \$2,000 and the second from Real Estate Analyst, in the amount of \$2,000.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., seconded by Commission President, William C. Parrish and passed it was ORDERED that the bid submitted by, Larry M. McDaniel, Inc., P.O. Box #5, Parkersburg, West Virginia, 26102, be and is hereby accepted. Said bid was accepted due to certain factors such as the deliver date. Bid submitted by Larry M. McDaniel, Inc., to be completed within fifteen (15) days vs. thirty (30) days in bid as submitted by Real Estate Analyst.

At 10:00 a.m the County Commission conducted a Public Hearing, for the purpose of input from local citizens on the filing of application for a Small Cities Block Grant administered by the Governor's Office of Economic and Community Development. In attendance at the hearing was Mr. Robert Morris, Mrs. Margaret Batten, Mr. Lewis C. Fortner and Mr. Carl E. Carney representing the Mineral Wells Public Service District. The group met with the Commission to request \$750,000.00 to fund a sewer project of which is estimated to effect from 900 to 1000 homes in the Mineral Wells, Pettyville area. Also attending the hearing was Mr. Edwin Garber, Councilman, for the City of Williamstown. Mr. Garber requested \$200,000.00 to be used to black top and resurface various streets as well as aide in the sewage problem in that area. The Commission

pointed out that the requests could not be split. Mr. Parrish went on to say that they would reach a decision no later than Tuesday, April 26th, 1983.

IN RE: LEVY ORDER--1983-1984.

The County Commission having ascertained that the net amount to be raised by a levy of taxes for the Current Fiscal Year (1983-1984) for County current proposes will be \$2,687,549.00, according to the estimate made and entered of record on the 24th day of March, 1983, the said estimate having been made as required by law, and no one appearing to object to same or take exceptions thereto, and the State Tax Commissioner having approved the same in writing, it is therefore ORDERED that the said Estimate and the rates of Levy proposed therein be approved and the following levies made on each One Hundred Dollars valuation in each class of property, viz:

Class I	14.3%	Class III	57.2%
Class II	28.6%	Class IV	57.2%

for the purposes aforesaid, based upon the last assessment therein as follows:

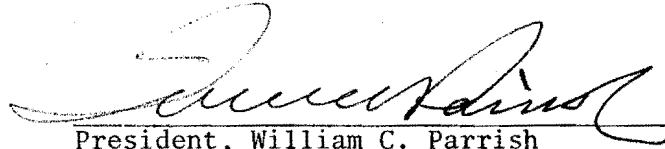

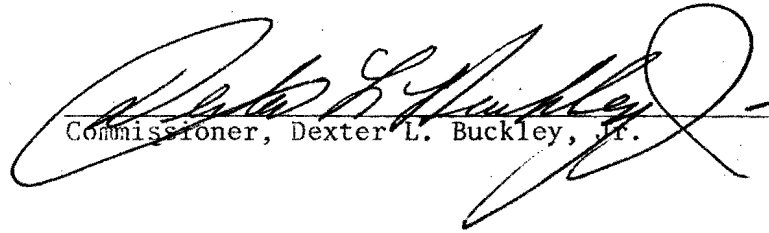
