On this day came Bill Pfalzgraf for the public hearing on the issuance of \$310,000 bond resolution, Dan and Tania Kniska, for the purpose of expanding beverage distribution facility. Mr. Greg Frazier was present and registered an objection alledging Coors is anti-union. Commissioner Shaver made the motion to adjourn hearing, seconded by Commissioner Buckley, made unanimous by President Parrish.

The Commission on a motion made by Commissioner Shaver, seconded by Commissioner Buckley, made unanimous by President Parrish, approved and signed final resolution on \$825,000 bond for MCKY Associations on property at 6th & Avery, to be occupied by law firm. Bond inducement was June 2, 1983 and public hearing was held in November.

Commission witnessed swearing in of James Smith to a 6-year reappointment to the Lubeck Public Service District.

After further consideration of bond resolution for Kniska, Commissioner Shaver moved to accept it, with Commissioner Buckley seconding the motion, and President Parrish made it unanimous.
