At 9:20 a.m. the Commission met with various interested persons in regard to the redistricting of the magisterial districts those in attendance were Rev. Harley Bailey, Mr. Ishmael Johnson, Mr. Robert Morgan and Mr. Hans Morgan. The gentlemen met before the Commission to state that they were in favor of Plan #1 - (3 - districts). Commission President, W. C. "Bill" Parrish stated that he had met with various interested persons at the City of Williamstown (City Building) to discuss the redistricting and the three proposals. Mr. Parrish stated that all three proposals were gone over and discussed in depth and at the end of the meeting the votes were in favor of Plan #3 - (5- districts).

At 9:37 a.m. the Commission met with Ms. Betty Young a representative from Executone Telephone Systems. Ms. Young met with the Commission to discuss their services for the Court House and Judicial Annex. Ms. Young agreed to do a study of the Court House to assess the needs of a phone system. Purchase Order #6763, to George D. Barnard Co., in the amount of \$270.00, for the County Clerk's Office.


Purchase Order #6757, to Chapman Printing, in the amount of \$305.00, for the County Clerk's Office.


