IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held June 28, 1983

On this day several local entities made requests to the Commission for monetary assistance from \$21,787 in revenue sharing monies. Following are listed those entities: 1. Country Roads and Travel requested \$2100 for tourist information centers (3 at \$700 each); 2. Domestic Violence Coalition requested \$4,000 which will be used to reinstate one 40 hour position that was cut back earlier this year; 3. Blennerhassett Volunteer Fire Department requested \$10,000 to equip their new 18 foot boat used in river rescue operations; 4. The Chief of PMBS Fire Department of Mineral Wells made a verbal request for \$8,000 which is what they still owe on their new fire truck; 5. Cpl. Roberts of the Deputy's Association requested \$3,400 for a new base station transmitter for their radio center; 6. The Wood County Extension Service Committee requested \$5,000.

Upon advertisement to install screen partitions in the Wood County Correctional Center, the following bids were received by the Commission: Murray Sheet Metal, 3112 Seventh St., Parkersburg, WV bid \$17,700; CGM Contractors, Rt. 14, Vienna, WV bid \$16,511; Partitions, Inc., P. O. Box 5027, Vienna, WV bid \$12,500; Singer Sheet Metal, 510 East Street, Parkersburg, WV bid \$25,323. It was the unanimous decision of this Commission to lay bids over for further advisement with disposition to be made at a later session of this Commission.

It was the unanimous decision of this Commission to sell 6 - 10 window air conditioners to the Wirt County Commission for \$1 each.

The Wood County Commission this day signed an Order which states, "The Wood County Commission, having advertized for bids on April 19, 1983, for a physician for the Wood County Correctional Center, pursuant to the West Virginia Code, Chapter 7, Article 7, Section 7, and receiving no bids do hereby declare it an emergency that the services of a Jail Physician be acquired." At three o'clock the Commission met with Sharon Lynch, Larry Allen, Sam Beverage, Bob Scalf, and Fred Fields in regard to Godbey Field. The Commission was informed that some ditching had been started and Fred Fields will send Mr. Parrish a letter informing him what needs to be done in regard to the junkyard. Another meeting was scheduled for July 19 at 3 p.m.

The Commission received and approved the following Purchase Orders:


Purchase Order #7128, to R. D. Wilson, in the amount of \$61.45, for the Correctional Center.




