Smith, County Clerk, and the Bar Association has not reported with the County Commission and no meeting was held. After lengthy discussion, Commissioner, Holmes Shaver asked Mrs. Campbell if she would like to be contacted for participation in the meeting with H. K. Smith and the Bar Association. She replied that she would and gave her phone number to Sibyl Rowan, County Administrator.
