IN RE: Minutes of the Meeting held Nov. 22, 1983

Present: President, William C. Parrish  
Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr.

Today Darlene Roberts, Joan Woods, Margaret Monroe, and Emily Bradley from Magistrate's Court building came before the Commission to register a complaint about the lack of cleanliness in said building. President Parrish explained the Commission would work out a way of obtaining extra help from Frank Settle at the Welfare Office. Floors are to be stripped and waxed and some carpet is to be torn up and replaced with tile.

Mr. Bob Risher came before the Commission with a request for Revenue Sharing funds in the amount of \$6195 for the Mid-Ohio Valley Fellowship Home. Funds are to help offset costs of roof repair.

Judge Joseph Handlan came in to tell the Commission that the carpet runners in the halls of the Judicial Building were excellent. He also registered a complaint about the manner in which they are billed for phone calls in the Judicial Building.

Sworn in today on the Development Authority Board were Mike Matheny, Bob Newberry, and W. C. Parrish, John Seafiler.

At 11 a.m. Andrew and Elias Corra of C & C Development Co., and Tom Dobbies and Peter Huber of the City of Parkersburg, came before the Commission with a petition for annexation of property owned by the Corras (36th & Murdoch) into the city of Parkersburg. President Parrish read a report in which there were no objections from county surveyor and there being no objections from anyone present, Commissioner Buckley moved to accept the petition and President Parrish so Ordered it accepted.

The Commission signed today an Order accepting a quote from Charlie Abdella in the amount of \$4,000 to sandblast all wrought iron on floors 1-4 in Wood County Courthouse and to refinish wooden railings on these same floors. Other quotes received: Murray Sheet Metal, \$10,000; Litton Fabrocaters, \$4,700. Copy of Order attached.

The Commission signed a Personal Property tax ticket to be forwarded to Probate to be impropered for clerical error.
