Gentlemen:

Following our discussion of the Wood County Jail, I have read Judge Handlan's Interim Order and the NIC evaluation of conditions.


If you are to proceed in an orderly manner to correct existing jail problems and provide for the proper housing of female detainees and youthful offenders, you need a professional analysis of conditions as they exist, recommendations pertaining to upgrading and expanding capacity, and estimates of costs associated with the project.

This study will provide population projections by classifications: sentenced and unsentenced women, and youthful offenders. Schematic designs will define the relationships and scope of the project to establish estimated costs for its development.

We will be pleased to serve you in preparing a study to include the above. We will require approximately two months to prepare the study and our fee will be \$4,950. If these terms are acceptable to you, please return a signed copy of this letter proposal to us as authorization.


