On this day came Joe Carrico, Community Development Director, and Lawrence Ronning, legal counsel for Lubeck Public Service District-Homewood Road Water Transmission Main Construction, to bring forth a notice of award for consideration after having advertised and accepted bids for said project. Low bidder was Boone Coleman Construction of Portsmouth, Ohio.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Holmes R. Shaver, to accept bid from Boone Coleman. Commission President, William C. Parrish voted against the motion, stating he was in favor of awarding contract to Everett L. Harper and Son, a local contractor. Copy of Order is attached.





This day, Joseph L. Carrico, Wood County Community Development Director and Lawrence M. Ronning, legal counsel for the above referenced project, did bring forth a notice of award for the Commission's consideration that after having duly advertised and accepted bids and after having been advised of the legal ramifications and further that the 30-day bid extension will expire on Sunday, September 11, 1983, and that the contract for the above referenced project be awarded to the apparent responsible low bidder of Boone Coleman Construction, Inc., of Portsmouth, Ohio.

After considerable discussion, Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. made the motion to award the contract for \$100,607.50 to Boone Coleman Construction, Inc., and the President William C. Parrish be authorized to execute the necessary documents for the project. Commissioner Holmes R. Shaver seconded the motion. Commission President William C. Parrish voted against the motion, stating that he favored awarded the contract to the local contractor, Everett L. Harper and Son whose bid was \$60.38 higher than Boone Coleman Construction, Inc.
