

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: The minutes of the meeting held
August 27, 1984

Today in the County Commission a petition from Edwin William Turley asking that his father, Alria P. Turley, be declared legally incompetent was heard today. Mr. David Underwood, Attorney at Law, had been appointed guardian ad litem for Mr. Turley. He testified that he felt it would be in Mr. Turley's best interest to be declared incompetent, and to have a committee appointed to look after his affairs, financial and otherwise. Dr. R. M. Biddle testified that Mr. Turley is in a constant state of confusion and fantasy. Mr. Underwood asked the Doctor if there was, in his opinion, any chance of improvement for Mr. Turley. Dr. Biddle said he felt there was none, and that Mr. Turley is completely dependent on other people for his everyday needs. Commissioner Homes Shaver made a motion that Mr. Alria P. Turley be declared legally incompetent. Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., seconded and President William C. Parrish made the vote unanimous. Mr. Edwin William Turley was appointed committee for his father by a motion from President Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Shaver, and made unanimous by Commissioner Buckley. Mr. Turley was required to post a \$50,000.00 bond which can be adjusted after reviewing his father's assets.

Next, the Commission heard a petition from Mrs. Orpha S. Wilcox, asking that her daughter, Janice K. Wilcox, be declared legally incompetent. She was represented by George Shedan. Miss Wilcox is 45 years old, and has spent her entire life with her mother. Mrs. Wilcox testified that she is totally dependent and disoriented. David Underwood, acting as guardian ad litem, testified that Miss Wilcox is in the same category as a baby, having to be diapered and such. He felt it would be in her best interest to be declared incompetent. An affidavit from Dr. Paul Modie was submitted supporting the testimony given. President Parrish made a motion to declare Janice K. Wilcox incompetent, motion seconded by Commissioner Buckley, made unanimous by Commissioner Shaver. After evaluating Miss Wilcox's assets it was decided that Mrs. Wilcox would post a property bond of \$10,000.00. President Parrish then made a motion to appoint Mrs. Orpha S. Wilcox committee for her daughter, Janice K. Wilcox, seconded by Commissioner Buckley, and made unanimous by Commissioner

Shaver.

Today much discussion centered around the allocating of \$71,400.00. The Commission announced that they intend to give the Correctional Guards either a \$200.00 or \$250.00 a month increase in their salaries. This brought department heads Juanita Coe, Eugene Knotts, H. K. Smith, and L. W. Bechtold, in to see the Commission. They basically said that they did not begrudge the Correctional Officers a raise, but felt they each had experienced personnel that also deserved raises. Juanita Coe was especially adamant in stating her displeasure with the situation.

The cooks from the Correctional Center came before the Commission today to request a pay raise. Alice Lamm stated that she had been with the County for approximately eight years and is only making \$4.23 per hour. Roella Newbrough and Debbie Byrd also expressed displeasure with their \$3.35 per hour rate. The Commission told them they are sympathetic to their situation, but did not at this time know where they could come up with more money.

Chuck Steele from Baker-Watts, brought the Bond Issue papers for the Commissioners' signatures. The Bond money will be available to first-time home buyers at the rate of 10.9%. An Order will be put on Thursday's minutes.

Jackie Norman was sworn in as a Correctional Officer today.

Susan Lattimer, Dean Sparks, and Steve Tuck were sworn in as members of the Commission on Crime and Delinquency.




