

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: The Minutes of the Meeting held August 30, 1984

Today at 9:30 a.m., the Commission opened the only bid received for 91 election kits. The bid was accepted from and awarded to Casto & Harris from Spencer, WV, in the amount of \$3,935.75, with extra kits costing \$43.25 each. Another bid was received, but not opened as it missed the deadline. The bid was received from Dayton Legal Blank Company at 12:30 p.m.

At 10:00, The Sylvia Ireland incompetency hearing was resumed. It had been continued from August 2, 1984. Present were Mr. Zivkovich representing the petitioner Mrs. Francis Rogers, Mr. Zimmerman for Mrs. Ireland, and Mr. Staley as guardian ad litem. The parties have still failed to reach any agreement among themselves. There was no real testimony given today, however, Mr. Zimmerman asked that he might still have the right to submit more testimony should he or his clients feel the need to do so. Much discussion centered around a Committee for Mrs. Ireland's physical self. The parties asked for another continuance based on the fact that a niece of Mrs. Ireland might be considered a suitable Committee, but the parties have not been able to discuss the matter with her as she has been out of town. The parties were granted a continuance to Monday, September 10, 1984 at 10:30 a.m., and the hearing was adjourned with Commissioner Shaver strongly urging the parties to work out a solution that all parties involved could consider amicable.

The Commission sent a letter to the Finance Department instructing them to transfer \$5,000.00 from Entitlement 15, Jug Run Project, to Williamstown Volunteer Ambulance Service.

An Order was put on today dated August 27, 1984, for the signing of the Single Family Mortgage Revenue Bonds, 1984 Series A, Contract of Purchase. A copy of the Order is attached.






There was one other bid from Dayton Legal Blank Co., but it was received to late for the opening. It was received at 12:30, August 30, 1984.
