This morning daily business was first on the agenda for the Commission. Purchase Orders, personal property imprompers and invoices for the Finance department were all signed.

At 9:30 a.m. Ernest M. Douglass was sworn in as Special Fiduciary Commissioner, effective January 1 to July 1, 1985. He will be filling the position left vacant by the election of his father, Dan Douglass, to the Judge of the Circuit Court. As of July 1, 1985 Eugene T. Hague, Jr. will serve as Fiduciary Commissioner. He also took his oath today.

At 10:15 Ralph P. Husk was sworn in as acting Chief Law Enforcement Deputy/Chief Tax Deputy with the Wood County Sheriff's Department. This appointment was to be effective November 20, 1984, and will expire at the end of the current Sheriff's term on December 31, 1984.


Today Prosecuting Attorney, Harry Deitzler, brought before the Commission a letter requesting a transfer of a total of \$5000.00 from line item #405-3000 Criminal Investigations to two of his salary line items. The letter notes that the purpose of these modifications is to allow compensation adjustments to his staff salaries, which he feels necessary to prevent further and imminent attrition. The Commission then sent a letter to Finance to make the transfer.
