After the hearing daily business was taken care of. Several purchase orders were signed. Copies are available in the Administrator's office.


Mary Rader as Director of the Wood County Planning Commission, presented the Commission with a new plat of Ferrell's Valley. A copy of the Order is attached.


Having no further business or appointments, the Commission adjourned at noon.


IN RE: FERRELL'S VALLEY RECREATIONAL SUBDIVISION
