Today the Commission heard a petition from Patty Arnold to declare her daughter Charlotte E. Arnold legally mentally retarded. David Underwood acting as guardian ad litem, stated that the doctors' affidavits were in order and he submitted his answer in writing agreeing that Charlotte E. Arnold should be declared legally mentally retarded. Commissioner Buckley then made a motion to declare Charlotte E. Arnold mentally retarded. Motion was seconded and made unanimous by President Parrish. Commissioner Buckley then made a motion to have Charlotte's mother, Patty, appointed committee for her. This motion was also seconded and made unanimous by President Parrish.

Next came Mr. William Mays to be reappointed to the Board of the Claywood Park Public Service District. He was accompanied by Attorney William Seufer.

A Timber Contract and Timber Deed was signed today by the Commission for timbering some land at the Wood County Airport. A copy of the Order is attached.



The Wood County Commission today signed a Timber Contract & Timber Deed in the amount of \$13,000.00, with the Heassley Hardwood Lumber Company of Washington County, Ohio, to timber all of that real estate owned by the Wood County Airport Authority and/or the Wood County Commission, as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto that is in the shaded area. All said timber shall be cut and removed on or before April 25, 1985, with the exception of that the flagged area of approximately 6 acres on J & L shall be cut and removed on or before December 25, 1984. Said contract accepted upon motion by Commissioner Buckley, made unanimous by President Parrish.




