IN RE: The Minutes of the Meeting held October 25, 1984

This morning Mr. Robert A. Chichester was reappointed to the Board for the Union Williams Public Service District.

Today the Elizabeth Pratt and Kathryn Sturm incompetencies continued. Lisa Yoke was present as guardian ad litem for both women. Kathryn Sturm was present for the hearing and stated that she understood the proceedings and had no objection to them. Upon a motion made by Commissioner Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Buckley, and made unanimous by Commissioner Shaver, both ladies were declared incompetent. Mrs. Janice Rost of Route 2, Walker, was appointed Committee for the person of both ladies on a motion made by President Parrish, seconded by Commissioner Buckley and made unanimous by Commissioner Shaver. Committee for the estates of both will be Parkersburg National Bank's Trust Department, by the same procedure.

William Pfalzgraf, Attorney for the Commission, and Jay Yeager presented a plan for funding of the Correctional Center Improvements. There was some discussion but no action was taken today.



The Commissioners signed a few purchase orders. Copies are available in the Administrator's Office.


The Commission adjourned at noon.


