This morning at 10:00 four representatives from the Odd Fellows Parkersburg Lodge #7 came to see the Commission. Spokesman Clayton Rollins, Vice Grand, explained to the Commission that there is a cemetery at Walker that belongs to the Lodge. They are having trouble keeping the grounds. There is a group of people in Walker who are willing to incorporate and take over the cemetery, however, under state law, the Lodge cannot legally give them the cemetery. It has to go to either a Fraternal Organization or a Church, neither of which is available. They are wondering if there is a possibility of the Lodge giving the cemetery to the County Commission, and they in turn giving the cemetery to the group. The Commission checked with Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Richard Richmond who asked that they come to his office to explain the situation. The Prosecuting Attorney's office will investigate the legalities and advise the Commission. The four, Clayton Rollins, Carey Clevenger, Tom Jackson, and George Sharpes thanked the Commission for looking into the matter as they left.



A letter was sent to the Finance Department concerning Mr. Joseph L. Carrico. A copy is attached.


Several Purchase Orders were signed today. Copies are attached.
