IN RE: The Minutes of the Meeting held  
September 24, 1984

This morning Mr. Tex Stephens appeared before the Commission to ask that an alley be closed. He was represented by Attorney Joe Brown. Several residents along the alley appeared to contest the alley being closed, saying that they use the alley as an access. They were represented by Attorney James Powell. After listening to both sides the Commission denied the petition.

County Administrator Mary Rader reported to the Commission that she had issued a building permit in the amount of \$2,002.00, to Universal Constructors from Tennessee. The company is constructing a 62 unit apartment complex for the elderly near Ohio Valley College.

At 10:00 a.m. President Parrish had to leave to attend a funeral.

Today Stephen Morgan petitioned the Court to declare his sister, Deanna P. Morgan 25, legally mentally retarded. Deanna was diagnosed at the age of four, and has been living at St. Mary's Colin Anderson Center since the age of six. She is confined to a wheelchair. Affidavits from her doctor stated that she was not able to care for herself or any financial matters that may come up in the future. Guardian ad litem, Lisa Yoke, confirmed this with her testimony. She stated that Deanna did respond when spoken to, but did not respond appropriately. Commissioner Shaver then made a motion that Deanna P. Morgan be declared mentally retarded. Commissioner Buckley seconded making the vote unanimous. The Commission then asked if there was anyone present that would like to be appointed Committee for

Deanna P. Morgan. Her brother, Stephen Morgan said that he did. Having no other parties desiring to be appointed Committee, Commissioner Shaver made a motion to appoint Stephen Morgan Committee for Deanna P. Morgan. Commissioner Buckley seconded the motion, making it unanimous.

The Commission broke for lunch at 12:00 p.m.

The Commission resumed at 1:00 p.m. with all Commissioners present.

Kim Marshall was sworn in as a member of the Wood County Planning Commission. His term will be for two and one half years.


Keith Litton was sworn in as a member of the Wood County Recreation Commission.
