APRIL 11, 1985


PRESENT: PRESIDENT PRO TEM, HOLMES R. SHAVER

The County Commission convened in regular session at 9:00 a.m. The first order of business was daily business. The Commission was updated by County Administrator, Mary Rader. Invoices as well as purchase orders were signed for processing.

At 10:00 a.m the Commission heard a petition to remove an administrator of the estate of Robert I. N. Joy. Said administrator is Mary Elizabeth Atkinson of Briscoe Road, Parkersburg, the youngest daughter of Robert Joy. The petitioners are her brothers and sisters. Ms. Atkinson is represented by Attorney Tom Munchmeyer. He is her private attorney for this matter, not the attorney for the estate. The petitioners are represented by Bill Kiger. Testimony was taken from several people and was quite lengthy. The session was tape recorded and the tape is available in the County Administrator's office. After reviewing the testimonies, the County Commission denied the petition with certain stipulations. These are: that the administrator has thirty (30) days to file a final settlement and that personal property inside the trailer owned by Mr. Joy be inventoried and added to the appraisal filed with the County Clerk. Commissioner Shaver strongly urged all parties to cooperate to see that this estate is taken care of as soon as possible. April 26, 1985 was designated as the deadline for filing the amended appraisal.

Having no further business or appointments, the Commission adjourned at noon.


IN RE: WOOD COUNTY COMMISSION--SPECIAL SESSION--TUESDAY, APRIL 16, 1985
