The Commission today received Notice of Approval of the Levy Estimate for Wood County from the State Tax Department. A copy of the letter and Order is attached.

There were two hearings scheduled for today, but both were continued by the attorneys involved.

O R D E R

The County Commission received the following letter of approval from the State Tax Department bearing the date April 10, 1985:

"NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF THE LEVY ESTIMATE

TO: Wood County

In accordance with the provisions of Article 8, Chapter 11 of the West Virginia Code, as amended, and contingent upon compliance with the provisions of Article 6, Section 38 of the West Virginia Constitution, the State Tax Commissioner of West Virginia hereby approves the Levy Estimate for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1985.

I find that any levy rates to be imposed in excess of those prescribed by the West Virginia Constitution were legally authorized by a vote of the people.

I find that the proper rates of levy are being used to retire any existing general obligation bond debt, and that such total debt is within the limits prescribed by the West Virginia Constitution and Code.


