
Next the Commission saw to daily business. Invoices and purchase orders were signed for processing.


At 10:30 the County Commission attended the groundbreaking ceremonies at the Salvation Army building. They are going to expand their facilities.


O R D E R

On April 22, 1985, Prosecuting Attorney Harry Deitzler appeared before Judge Joseph M. Handlan on behalf of the Wood County Commission, and informed the Court that the Wood County Correctional Center (Jail) was overcrowded with inmates and it is necessary to adopt the jail of another county for certain inmates held therein until said overcrowded conditions can be remedied. The inmates aforesaid are: Gerald Wilson, James McCumbers, James Tilton, James Schulties, Toy Buchannon, Raymond Haught, Leonard Pritt, Basil Stout, Worthy Hall, Warren Lightfritz, Michael Hones, Donald Biles and James Sommerville. The Commission further informed the Court that Sheriff S. F. Greiner had made arrangements with the Harrison County Jailer to house said prisoners, with the Court's approval, during the term of said overcrowdedness and the costs to the Wood County Commission will be \$25.00 per day per prisoner.

It was therefore ORDERED by the Court and the Commission so ORDERS that the aforesaid inmates be transferred to the Harrison County Jail. Said inmates were transported on April 22, 1985.


IN RE: Temporary Placement of Wood County Prisoners in Harrison County  
Jail because of overcrowdedness in Wood County Jail

This day appeared the Wood County Commission by Prosecuting Attorney, HARRY G. DEITZLER, and informed the Court that the Wood County Jail was overcrowded with inmates and it is necessary to adopt the jail of another county for certain inmates held therein until said overcrowded conditions can be remedied. The Commission further informed the Court that the inmates aforesaid are Gerald Wilson, James McCumbers, James Tipton, James Schultiess, Roy Buchannon, Raymond Haught, Leonard Pritt, Basil Stout, Worthy Hall, Warren Lightfritz, Michael Jones, Donald Biles and James Sommerville. The Commission further informed the Court that Sheriff S.F. Greiner had made arrangements with the Harrison County Jailer to house said prisoners, with the Court's approval, during the term of said overcrowdedness and the costs to the Wood County Commission will be \$25.00 per day for each prisoner so housed.


Wherefore, the Court finds it is necessary to adopt the Harrison County Jail to house Gerald Wilson, James McCumbers, James Tipton, James Schultiess, Roy Buchannon, Raymond Haught, Leonard Pritt, Basil Stout, Worthy Hall, Warren Lightfritz, Michael Jones, Donald Biles, and James Sommerville until said overcrowded conditions can be remedied.

It is therefore ORDERED that the prisoners aforesaid be transported and housed in the Harrison County Jail until said overcrowded conditions can be remedied and at the time said prisoners are to be returned to the Wood County Jail (Correctional Center).


