At 10:00 Mr. Charles Cline from ASCO Services, met with the Commission to demonstrate a transmitter to use for emergency messages. This transmitter could be used for 8 different types of messages. It works with the specific dial lines, or telephones lines.

The transmitter receives, decodes message and within 4 seconds will transmit message to the correct authority.

This system is specifically designed to be used with an existing system.

President Pro Tem, Holmes R. Shaver, told Mr. Cline that he thought that the County did not have a need for this system.

At 10:30 Ms. Cox from the Tax Department was sworn in by Deputy Polly Eaton.


Then at 10:35 Daily Business was taken care of by the signing of Purchase Orders and Invoices as well as Exonerations.
