
At 11:00 the Carpenters came in the sign the lease for the County Farm property.

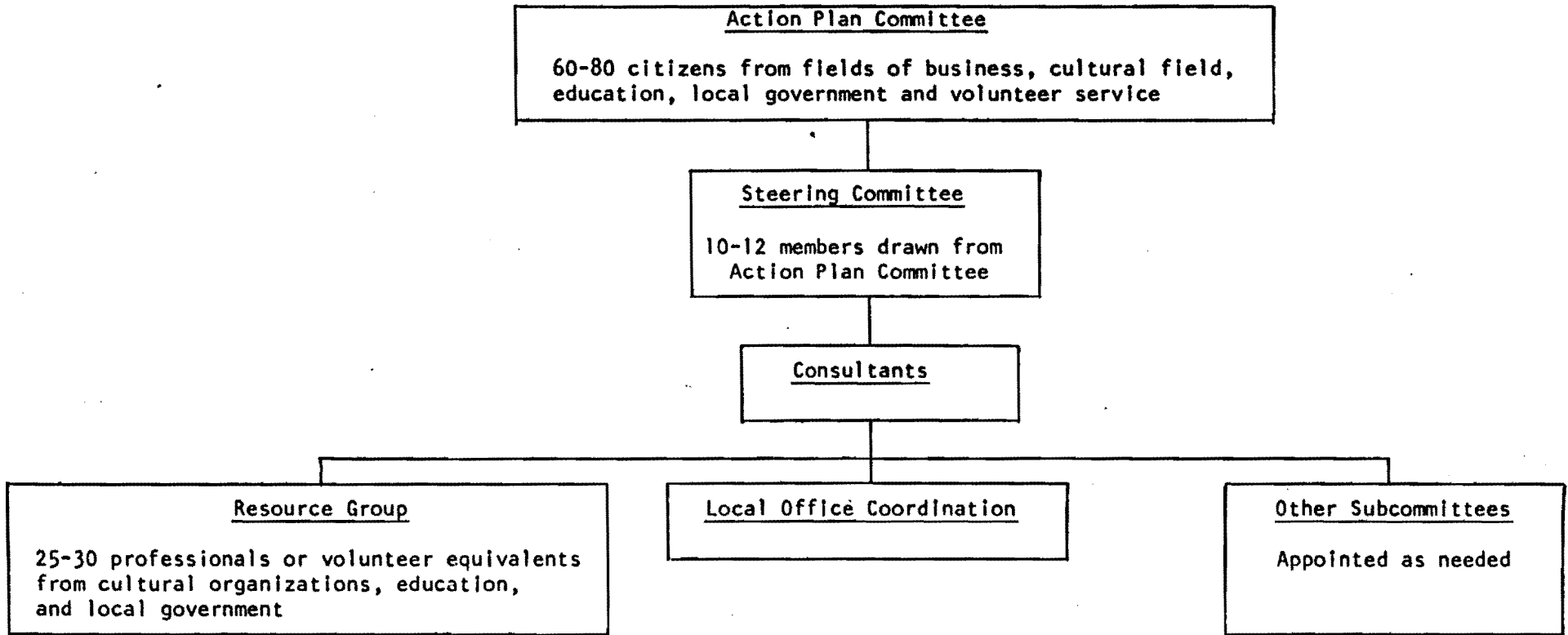

Schedule

November - January, 1986: Phase One: determine planning issues; establish planning committees; obtain Phase Two funds.

February - July, 1986: Phase Two: recommend services to strengthen cultural organizations in the region as well as new ways of using cultural resources to create more vital communities; determine best organizational structure to carry out recommended programs; determine cost of programs; recruit leadership to implement recommendations and obtain funds to help finance first year's operations.

September, 1986 - : permanent organization recommended by Action Plan undertakes recommendations guided by priorities established during the Action Plan process.

PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE COUNTY FARM, WOOD COUNTY  
WEST VIRGINIA

O R D E R

On this day, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., President of the County Commission of Wood County, entered into a lease agreement with Orval Fred and Edwina Elizabeth Carpenter for property known as the County Farm, Wood County. Said property consists of a two-story frame house. This lease is for the term of one year, from the 16th day of December, 1885, to the 16th day of December, 1886. The Carpenters shall pay rent in the sum of One Hundred Twenty-Five dollars (\$125.00) per month, in advanced, at the office of the Wood County Commission, Wood County Courthouse, Parkersburg, West Virginia.
