This morning at 9:30 a.m. Attorney Jerry Townsend came before the Commission on behalf of Mr. John E. O'Leary of 7508 Emerson Avenue, Parkersburg, with a petition to declare Margaret A. O'Leary legally incompetent. James Stealey was present as guardian ad litem. Mr. O'Leary testified that he is the alleged incompetent's brother. He stated that his sister Margaret, is totally bedfast at the Worthington Memorial Care Center. She is totally blind, cannot speak or hear. She will sometimes respond to touch. Mr. Stealey confirmed Mr. O'Leary's testimony and concurred with the recommendation that Margaret O'Leary be declared legally incompetent. At this point Commissioner Shaver made a motion that Margaret A. O'Leary be declared incompetent. Commissioner Guinn seconded and President Buckley made the vote unanimous. It was reported that the only income Ms. O'Leary receives is \$320.00 per month from Social Security. It was the unanimous decision of the Commission to appoint Mr. John E. O'Leary committee for the person as well as the estate of Margaret O'Leary. Mr. O'Leary was required to post a \$1,000. bond.


Today begins Equalization and Review for the County Commission. This will run all this week with the hours being 10:00 a.m. - Noon, and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Two of the Commissioners will be here at those times.

Having no further appointments or business, the County Commission
adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
