This morning Kim Marshall representing the Wood County Firefighters' Association, presented more petitions asking that a County Fire Board be established. There were several Wood County citizens present that voiced their opinions concerning the proposed fire fee. Those opposed generally said that they were upset because it takes ten(10) percent of the registered voters to establish the Fire Board, and it takes thirty (30) percent to oppose it. The session was tape-recorded and the tape is available in the County Administrator's office.

Prior to the Federal Flood Plain Ordinance being enacted, the Commission heard several citizens' opinions concerning this matter. This session was also tape recorded, and is available in the County Administrator's office. The Ordinance was enacted and a copy of the Ordinance is available in the Administrator's office.

Mayor Leach of Williamstown and Councilman Nelson also of Williamstown, met with the Commission to obtain information concerning the Fire Board and the proposed fee that is being considered. Commissioners Shaver and Guinn explained the process and the reasons the Firefighters' Association as well as the County Commission feel the need to act on this matter. The main reason being that the Commission funds the ten (10) Volunteer Fire Departments from Revenue Sharing received from the Federal Government, and this is likely to be cut completely from the Federal budget. This would leave the VFD's in a severe financial crunch.

Next, the Commission and Administrator Mary Rader took care of

daily business. Invoices and purchase orders were signed.

Having no further appointments or business, the Commission adjourned at noon.
