

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD JANUARY 24, 1985

PRESENT: PRESIDENT, DEXTER L. BUCKLEY, JR

Today the County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m. The first order for the day was daily business. County Administrator, Mary Rader, updated the Commission on daily activities concerning the Commission.

At 11:00 a.m. an incompetency hearing was held. President Buckley called the hearing to order. Attorney James Stealey presented the Commission a petition from Elmer C. Miller, 2300 6th Avenue, Parkersburg, to have his mother, Mable Mae Lions, declared legally incompetant. The proper affidavits were presented from Dr. A. P. Brooks as to why Mrs. Lions could not appear in person, and as to her present medical condition. Guardian ad litem Thomas Zimmerman also filed his answer agreeing that Mrs. Lions should be declared incompetant. Testimony from two of Mrs. Lions sons, Elmer and Hubert Miller, showed that Mrs. Lions cannot converse, get around by herself, or take care of her personal self. All of this being the result of a severe stroke suffered by Mrs. Lions in October 1984. Since that time Hubert Miller has been seeing to her financial affairs. It was the unanimous decision of this Commission that Mable Mae Lions be declared legally incompetant. Upon the motion of Commissioner Shaver, seconded by Commissioner Guinn, and made unanimous by President Buckley, Elmer Miller and Argell Lions were appointed co-committee for Mrs. Lions. Both are sons of hers. A \$5,000.00 bond is to be posted.

This day Sheriff Greiner requested that several prisoners be transported to the Harrison County Jail due to the fact that the Wood County Correctional Center is overcrowded. The Commission petitioned the Circuit Court through

the Prosecuting Attorney's office. The cost is \$25.00 per day per prisoner. This will be until such time as the Wood County Correctional Center is relieved of the current situation.

Having no further appointments or business, the Wood County Commission adjourned at noon.
