

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD JANUARY 28, 1985

Today Commissioner Holmes R. Shaver is attending the Annual West Virginia Association of Counties meeting for County Officials in Charleston, West Virginia.

Daily business was first on the agenda. County Administrator advised the Commission of daily activities concerning the County. Purchase orders as well as invoices for payment were signed.

At 10:00 a.m. the bid opening for the Blanket Bond Insurance for County officials was held. The following bids were received: McDonough Caperton for \$2,840.00; Erie Insurance Company for \$1,044.00; Chancellor Insurance for \$1125.00; and Regal & Padden for \$1500.00. Commissioner Guinn made a motion that the Commission take the bids under advisement and act on this Thursday, January 31, 1985. Said motion was seconded and made unanimous by President Buckley.

Investigation for
Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Charles Davis presented the Commission with papers for the Commission President's signature for extradition proceedings for one Richard Milton Starkey who is presently being held in the Washington County, Ohio Jail. He faces charges of uttering in Wood County.

At 11:00 a.m. came Attorney James W. Simonton to petition the Commission with a resignation of executor of the Mary Jean Shepherd estate. Said executor was Robert Arthur Price. Mr. Price qualified as executor on November 1, 1984. He suffered a heart attack on December 18, 1984. For health reasons, he is asking the Commission to accept his resignation as executor of this estate. Mrs. Flo Ann Shepherd, present, is willing to accept the duties of administering the estate of Mary Jean Shepherd. The Commission unanimous

ly voted to accept the resignation Robert Arthur Price, and appoint Flo Ann Shepherd as administrator.

Today Mr. George A. Ainsley of 19D Wildwood Drive, Parkersburg, was sworn in to the Wood County Planning Commission.

After lunch, the Commission inspected the Magistrates Court Building, the Judicial Annex, and the Wood County Courthouse. The Commission decided to get price quotes to replace carpet in the Magistrates Court Building in the areas of Magistrates Waters, Florence, the secretaries offices, and the lunch room. While at the Judicial Annex, the Commission informed Judge Joseph Handlan of the progress at the Magistrate Court Building.

Having no further business or appointments, the Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
