The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Carl Bradford from AT & T was scheduled for 10:00 a.m. this morning, but called and changed his appointment to Monday at 11:00 a.m. The Commission very much wishes to discuss the telephone system with Mr. Bradford.

The Commission today sent a letter to Mr. Fred Cutlip with the Governor's Office of Community Development to inform them that the Commission has chosen the Claywood Park Public Service District Deerwalk Extension as their project to be submitted under the Small Cities Block Grant program. The amount of the project is \$1,215,000.00 and will serve 225 residents.

The Commission today signed an ORDER indicating that the Commission intends to initiate the Hotel Tax which the Legislature enacted effective July 1, 1985. This will provide funds for the Wood County Travel Bureau to promote the area and also provide funding for recreation and the arts.

Daily business was seen to with County Administrator Mary Rader.

Having no further business or appointments, the Commission adjourned at noon.

IN RE: NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM BUILDING
PERMIT SYSTEM FOR WOOD COUNTY - AMENDMENT

O R D E R

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, desires to make an amendment to extend the Building Permit System to all areas of the County and Wood County will continue to follow the general provisions set forth in the Court Order regarding the National Flood Insurance Program, bearing date the 27th day of January, 1977, and appears of record in Court Order Book 40, Page 68.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, that it shall continue to do the following as per Court Order entered on January 27, 1977:

"1. Require building permits for all proposed construction or other improvements, within the unincorporated areas of Wood County, West Virginia."

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Commission of Wood County, that it desires to make a change and amend the AMENDING ORDER regarding the National Flood Insurance Program bearing date the 24th day of July, 1979, and appearing of record in Court Order Book 43, Page 127, as follows:

Under the heading of "RESOLUTION FOR THE FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM INDICATING INTEREST" delete: "(3) To appoint or designate a Building Permit Officer, under the direction of the Wood County Planning Commission," and insert in lieu thereof: "(3) To appoint or designate a Building Permit and Flood Insurance Inspector under the direction of the Wood County Commission,..."


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, that it shall continue to follow the provisions as set forth in Article II - ADMINISTRATION under the above-mentioned Order and made a matter of record in ORDER Book 40, Pages 69 and 70, and that it shall continue to follow the provisions as set forth in the Amending Order, bearing date the 24th day of July, 1979, and appearing of record in Court Order Book 43, Page 127, with the following addition to Section 2.06 Fees:


Applications for a building permit to locate, place, or maintain for residency purposes a mobile home or house trailer shall be accompanied by a \$2.00 fee, payable to the County.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and made unanimous, it is hereby ORDERED that the said changes be made, and the same are hereby APPROVED by the County Commission of Wood County.
