The first order of business was Daily Business by the signing of Invoices, Purchases Orders, as well as Improvers. The Administrator Mary Rader updated the Commissioners on Daily Business.

At 10:00 The Commission heard the petition of Charles E. Stout of Wood County, to have his sister Catherine Seevers declared legally incompetent. Mr. Stout testified that his sister is residing at Parkview Nursing Home. Mrs. Seevers is a widow. She is suffering from Alzheimer's disease. She cannot care for herself. She does not own property but she does have a \$30,000 CD investment along with a savings account and Social Security. Mr. Stout stated that his sister's income did not meet all of the bills and that he was making up the difference which amounted to about \$500 or \$600 a month. He stated that he visited her regularly and that it was about a year since she recognized him by name. Rebecca S. Hinnagan would be appointed committee for Mrs. Seevers. Elizabeth Pyles guardian ad litem did not have a chance to meet with Mrs. Seevers so the hearing will be continued and she will then enter her answer and the Order. A property Bond will be posted when an Affidavit of all Mrs. Seevers income has been entered as well. The tape of this hearing is on file in the Administrator's Office.

Having no further business or appointments the Commission adjourned at 4:00.
