IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY,
APRIL 17, 1986

PRESENT: PRESIDENT, HOLMES R. SHAVER
COMMISSIONER, DEXTER L. BUCKLEY, JR.

At 10:00 the Commission met with Attorney Jack Bailey, and members of the Sunrise Baptist Church and abutting land owner Mr. Robert C. Ferrebee to discuss the closing of Church Street. Church Street is located in the east side of Parkersburg District, outside the cities authority. The Attorney stated that the Commission had the authority to close the street. President, Holmes R. Shaver asked if the owners of the abutting had signed the petition that was submitted to the Commission, the attorney answered that they had. It was also stated that the Ferrebees were the only owners of property that abutts Church Street, besides the Church property. President asked if there was anyone present that objected to the Street being closed, no one was heard. Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. made the motion that the street be closed, Commissioner, Lewis E. Guinn, seconded, and President, Holmes R. Shaver made it unanimous. An Order will be filed today.

At 10:30 the Commission held the Sealed Bid Opening for Roller Shelving for the County Clerk's Office. The Commission opened the Bid received from Casto & Harris. This bid had two quotes, the first was for the specified shelving with a slanted top, the price was \$2,322 per unit for a total of \$11,610 for five. The second quote was for a shelving unit with a flat top, with a price of \$2,114 per unit, for a total of \$ 10,570. The Commission will take the bid under advisement. A copy of the Order is on file.

The Commission signed a letter addressed to Mr. William S. Ritchie, Jr., Commissioner of West Virginia Department of Highways. The Commission also signed a letter addressed to County Clerk H.K. Smith, concerning the transfer of monies from the School Fund to the General County Fund.

The Commission signed a Memorandum addressed to the Elected Officials concerning Emergency Purchasing, beginning May 1, 1986.





O R D E R


The Commission having ascertained that the net amount necessary to be raised by a Levy of Taxes for the Current Year for county current purposes will be Three Million, Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand, Eight Hundred Fifty-Four Dollars (\$3,950,824), according to the estimate and entered of record on the 27th day of March, 1986, and said estimate having been published as required by law, and no one appearing to oppose the same or to take exception thereto, and the State Tax Commissioner having heretofore by a letter writing bearing date the 14th day of April, 1986, approving said Levy Estimate as submitted, it is therefore ORDERED that said Estimate and the Rates of Levy proposed therein be approved and the following levies be laid on each One Hundred Dollars valuation of each Class of Property, viz:


