IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 3, 1986

At 9:15 the Commission met with the Correctional Officers. President of the Correctional Officers Association, Doug Smith stated that the petition was submitted and came to listen to the County Commission's side. President, Holmes R. Shaver stated that the Sheriff has submitted his preliminary budget and until they meet to discuss the budget, nothing could be done. He further stated that the Commission cannot and will not set the salaries. Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn stated that the Commission would do their best and then it was up to the Sheriff. Correctional officer Cathy Evans stated that if the Commission did not set enough in the Salary Line item their salary would remain the same. This meeting was called because of an Order brought up by the Correctional Officers, a copy is attached. The meeting ended at approximately 9:25.

At 9:25 Bob Morgan stated that the Commission could not change the levy rate. President Holmes R. Shaver, stated that they would adjust it to the Counties needs. Bob Morgan stated that was misleading because the Commission had no control over 70% of the income.

At 2:00 the Commission met with Robert Tebay, Kim Marshall, and Dick Richmond to discuss the fire levy and the ways to put the levy on the ballot, by the primary election.

At 3:15 Bruce Stravinski, an International Appraisal repre-

senting Keene Industries, came before the Commission to ask the Commission to lower the 18% tax increase for Keene Industries. President, Holmes R. Shaver, stated that the 18% was needed for the County and if it was changed for them it would have to be changed for everyone. President, Holmes R. Shaver further stated that if they felt that the Company was over appraised that the Commission would have a state appraiser come in to consider it. The forms were given to be filled out, and filed in the Probate Office.

President, Holmes R. Shaver, left at 3:30 for a meeting in Charleston. The meeting with Mr. Stravinski was continued until Tuesday at 10:00, during the Board of Equalization hours.

Having no further Business or appointments the Commission adjourned at 4:00.
