The only bid recieved was from Dayton Legal Blank. A motion was made by Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. and seconded by Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn, and made unaminous by President, Holmes R. Shawer, to accept the bid of \$2663.40 for 92 election kits.

At 10:30 the Commission met with Jennings Hastings.

Later the Commission met with Attorneys Richard Haykurst and Howard Suefer, in regard of the wage suit. President, Holmes R. Shaver stated that it was agreed that they be employed for this case.

At 1:00 Jerry Burns was sworn in to the Wood County Recreation Commission Board.

At 2:20 Cynthia Brown was sworn in the Wood County Planning Commission.

Having no further business or appointments the Commission adjourned at 4:00.

ORDER

This 24th day of February, 1986, pursuant to the Order entered herein on the 16th day of January, 1986, this proceeding came on for hearing before the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia; and this day came the Petitioner, the City of Vienna, a municipal corporation, by David G. Underwood, its attorney, and William F. Owens, its Mayor, no other parties or persons appearing herein.

At the conclusion of all the evidence, the Commission, after due and mature consideration, is of the opinion to and doth hereby find that --

1) The petition with exhibits, was filed before the Commission, in open session, on January 16, 1986, seeking annexation by minor boundary adjustment of certain real property described therein.

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- 2) Notice of this hearing and proposed annexation by the Petitioner was duly published in the Parkersburg News and Parkersburg Sentinel, once a week for two successive weeks, to-wit: January 20, 1986 and January 27, 1986, all as more fully shown by the publisher's affidavits' of publication tendered and FILED this day, said publications having commenced more than fourteen days prior to this date.
- 3) Notice of this hearing and proposed annexation by the Petitioner was duly posted on January 16, 1986 at not less than five public places within the area proposed to be annexed, all as shown on the return made by Robert D. Whited, and FILED HEREIN.
- 32 4) The area proposed to be annexed consists of 12.038 acres, more or less, and is situate in Williams District, West Virginia, and is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point in the southerly line of Greenmont Hills Subdivision, a corner to Van Dyke; thence with the southerly line of Greenmont Hills Subdivision, S. 62° 58' E.235.23 feet to a point and S. 64° 21' E. 715 feet to a point; thence S. 29° 28' 59" W. 171.25 feet; thence S. 51° 13' 56" W. 520.59 feet to a point in the northerly line of Pleasant Valley Subdivision; thence with the northerly line of Pleasant Valley Subdivision, N. 63° 34' W. 592.41 feet to a point in the line of James M. Thompson; thence N. 26° 26" W. 264 feet to a point; thence N. 62° 26' W. 206.16 feet to a point; thence N. 26° 34' E. 126.30 feet to a point; thence S. 62° 26' E. 75 feet to a point; thence N. 26° 34' E. 243.40 feet to the place of beginning, containing 12.038 acres, more or less.

- 7) No persons presently reside in the area proposed to be annexed, and the following persons, firms, or corporations are the owners or freeholders of the area, to-wit: Frank R. Rotunda and Barbara J. Rotunda (Lot 8, Section 1); Pete J. DePond and Flora A. DePond (Lot 14, Section 1); Terry L. Nemesek and Sharon R. Nemesek (Lot 13, Section 1); Delmar A. Fischer, Jr. and Jane F. Fischer (Lot 3, Section 1); Douglas E. Cochran and Constance L. Conchran (Lot 19, Section 1); Steven D. Ayers and Carolyn S. Ayers (Lot 14, Section 1); Robert B. McHenry and Paula T. McHenry (Lot 16, Section 1); Glenbrook Developer's, Inc. a corporation.
- 8) No persons have appeared and registered herein any objection or opposition to the proposed annexation as applied for by the Petitioner, and, the aforementioned freeholders have indicated their respective consents and approval to the proposed annexation as evidenced by written documents and deeds of conveyance, copies of all of which have been FILED this day.

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In view of the foregoing findings of fact, this Commission accordingly concludes that the petition is in proper form; that the area proposed to be annexed is a proper subject for annexation by minor boundary adjustment, and, therefore, it is

ORDERED that the following described property, formerly situate in Williams District, Wood County, West Virginia, be, and the same is, hereby annexed, by minor boundary adjustment, to the Petitioner herein, and, accordingly, the corporate limits of the City of Vienna be, and the same, are hereby changed by virtue of such annexation, to include said property described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the southerly line of Greenmont Hills Subdivision, a corner to Van Dyke; thence with the southerly line of Greenmont Hills Subdivision, S. 62° 58' E. 253.23 feet to a point and S. 64° 21' E. 715 feet to a point; thence S. 29° 28' 59" W. 171.25 feet; thence S. 51° 13' 56" W. 520.59 feet to a point in the northerly line of Pleasant Valley Subdivision; thence with the northerly line of Pleasant Valley Subdivision, N. 63° 34' W. 592.41 feet to a point in the line of James M. Thompson; thence N. 26° 26" W. 264 feet to a point; thence N. 62° 26' W. 206.16 feet to a point; thence N. 26° 34' E. 126.30 feet to a point; thence S. 62° 26' E. 75 feet to a point; thence N. 26° 34' E. 243.40 feet to the place of beginning, containing 12.038 acres, more or less.


