At 9:55 Jane Burdett was sworn in to the Wood County Crime and Delinquency Commission.


At 10:00 Joesph Banasik, Bill Vaughn, Ralph Olex, and Snoden Kesterson, came before the Commission to state their views on the tax increase. Bill Vaughan stated that he owned rental property that he could not sell because the economy was so rough. Corrina Francis stated that the School Board would not ask the levy rate be lowered because that would cause them to loose money from the State. Mr. Kesterson stated that he was angry with the reappraisal and the errors made in Wood County. Mr. Kesterson further stated that Representative Joe Albright had publicly stated that the re-appraisal would not be used this year. Mr. Kesterson stated that the State Law must be changed, and asked the Commission to pass a resolution and send it to the Office of the Governor. Also, take back the tax increase and work to change the State Formula, or resign. Joesph Banasik stated that it was a constitutional right to own a home and this tax increase takes away that basic right. Corinna Francis stated that she had brought with her a bill that she had received from the State, and would like the Commission to look at it. Presdient Holmes R. Shaver, said that he would. The meeting ended at about 11:30.
