JULY 10, 1986

At 10:00 the Wood County Commission held a Revenue Sharing Entitlement 17 Hearing, this hearing is to amend the Revenue Sharing Entitlement 17 Budget. The hearing began by President Shaver stating that the County received \$143,460 from Revenue Sharing and expect the 4th allocation early in October and anticipate approximately \$90,000. Within the next week a decision will be made on who the Commission will fund. Edwin Dils and Virginia Farmar from the Wood County Crime & Delinquency Commission asked for \$1,000 for the testing of work release and those on probation for drugs and alcohol. President Shaver stated that the \$1,000 had already been funded. Bob Ishman from the Mid-Ohio Valley Fellowship Home, and a resident of the Fellowship Home, Mr. Lewis. Mr. Lewis told the Commission what a service the Fellowship Home was to him and the community. Ralph Boreguard and Dale Hartough from the Cultural Action and Arts Bridge, asked the Commission to support the Arts Bridge program. Commissioner Buckley, Jr. asked what amount was needed. The amount requested was \$10,000.00. Gail Hartshorn requested funds to complete Emergency Operation Service Project, for training equipment. Mr. Hartshorn updated the Commission on the progress of the Emergency Service Program. Snowden Kesterson asked Mr. Hartshorn about the transportation of

Mustard Gas and stated that he would like the Commission to sign a resolution prohibiting the transportation of Mustard Gas through this area. Gail Hartshorn stated that there was nothing definite on the transportation of the gas at this time. Mark Hendershot from the Deer Walk Volunteer Fire Department asked the Commission to remember the Volunteer Fire Departments. Snowden Kesterson asked the Commission about the convicted felons and the number of them housed in the Correctional Center. President Shaver stated that he would have to check with the Sheriff. Snowden Kesterson stated that he was against a Regional Jail, he felt that it would not save money because of the transportation of the prisoners. The meeting ended at 10:26.

At 10:28 the Commission went with Maintenance Superintendent Emmett Pickens to inspect a hot water tank where Freon had started to burn on a pipe.

The Commission signed Purchase Orders, Invoices and Personal Property Improvers.

Having no further business or appointments the Commission adjourned at noon.
