JUNE 23, 1986

The Commission took care of daily business with County Administrator, Mary Rader.

At 11:00 the Commission held an Alleged Incompetency hearing on Janie E. Francis. The witnesses were sworn in by Deputy Clerk Polly Eaton. The papers were filed with the Commission. Norma Craig, 3801-9th Avenue, Vienna, is the daughter of Janie E. Francis. Ms. Craig testified that Mrs. Francis is 82 years of age and is residing at her home. Mrs. Francis is suffering from diabetes, hypertension and a brain disorder. Her physical condition has declined within the last two years. Mrs. Francis owns a two-story house. She can feed herself but she has strange eating habits. She can communicate at times she seems to not understand. Mr. Francis testified that Mrs. Francis is unable to take care of her bills she cannot read or write. Based on Dr. Jordan's affidavit and the statement from the Guardian Ad litem Commissioner Guinn made the motion seconded by Commissioner Buckley, Jr. and made by Commission President Shaver, that Mrs. Janie E. Francis be declared incompetent. Mrs. Francis owns a home and a joint bank account at the Ohio Valley National Bank, approximately \$7,000 each are in the Savings and Checking Accounts. She owns no insurance or stocks or bonds. She receives a check from Social Security. The house is valued at about \$35,000. President Holmes R. Shaver asked

if there was anyone here who wished to be appointed as committee for Mrs. Francis. No one was heard. Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. made the motion seconded by Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn and made unanimous by President Holmes R. Shaver, that Mrs. Norma Jean Craig be appointed as Committee. A \$35,000 property bond will be posted, an Order will be filed today.


At 1:30 the Commission held a Bond Issue and Public Hearing for Medicon. Notice of the hearing was read, American Health Interprises Limited West Rehabilitation Services, owns and will operate the hospital with employees of St. Joesph Hospital assisting. The project has gone before the Housing Authority. The amount has been changed from seven million to ten million. A motion was made by Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn and seconded by Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. and made unanimous by President Holmes R. Shaver. No one was present to object. The meeting ended at 1:40.

The Commission signed purchase orders and personal property improvers. Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn left at 2:50 and Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. left at 3:45. President Holmes R. Shaver signed a Legal Notice on a Public Hearing set for July 10, 1986 at 10:00 a.m. to amend the Budget for Entitlement 17 of Revenue Sharing.

Having no further business or appointments the Commission adjourned at noon.
