IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY,
MARCH 6, 1986.

At 10:00 the Commission heard the Estate of Edwin Wallis Baxter. The attorney Jeff Reed tendered the notice of publication and the Sheriff's Notice of Service to Ms. Buckouski. Real property involved in the Estate, Ms. Deloris M. Baxter is seeking clear ownership for herself. Attorney Jeff Reed stated that he had checked the County Clerk's Office and Ms. Buckouski had not filed an Estate Appraisal. President, Holmes R. Shaver stated that an Administrator must file within 60 days and Ms. Buckouski has not. The Attorney asked that Ms. Bouckouski be removed as CTADB. Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn made the motion, Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. seconded and President Holmes R. Shaver made it unanimous, that Ms. Bouckouski be removed as CTADB and that Ms. Deloris M. Baxter be appointed as CTADB. The Order will be filed today. The hearing ended at 10:10.

Bob Morgan discussed the fire levy with the Commission after the hearing.

At 11:00 Pauline Petty came before the Commission to discuss emergency procedures and system the County could use in the event of an emergency. Ms. Petty discussed evacuating methods and devices used in a chemical leak emergency. President, Holmes R. Shaver stated to Ms. Petty, continue her work but work closely with Mr. Gail Hartshorn, Director of Emergency Services. Pauline Petty informed the Commission of a meeting

on Safety Procedures, in Charleston, on Friday at 8:00 a.m. Beth Mylas from Space Age Technology introduced herself to the Commission and stated that her Company could help service the systems that Ms. Petty had spoken of. She left her card and stated she would follow up with a letter of introduction.

The Commission signed an Amended Order, pursuant to Order dated March 3, to include the ratification of the Ordinance that was accepted and ordered to be placed on the primary election ballot on May 13, 1986. A copy of the Order is attached.



Commission President Holmes R. Shaver signed an Order in regards to the annexation of property by minor boundary adjustment. James W. Simonton, City of Parkersburg's City Attorney, and freeholder Orville L. Hardman represented a corrected description of the property to be annexed by the City of Parkersburg. A copy of the Order is on file in the Administrator's Office.


"Pursuant to an order made and entered on the 3rd day of March, 1986,

to be held in the County of Wood, on the 13th day of May, 1986.


It is further ORDERED that a copy of said Ordinance and copy of said

IN RE: Annexation of Property by
Minor Boundary Adjustment

O R D E R

On the th 6 day of March, 1986, came the City of Parkersburg, by James W. Simonton, City Attorney, and also came the freeholder, by Orville L. Hardman, whereupon the parties represented to the Commission that a corrected description of the property to be annexed by the City of Parkersburg had been agreed upon, and that the property which was agreed upon by the City and freeholders to be intended to be encompassed within the original application, is within the confines of the original description contained in the Resolution adopted by the Council of the City of Parkersburg, and subsequently published as part of a legal notice.

The freeholders thereupon advise the Commission that they withdraw their objection to the annexation.

Upon consideration of all of which the Commission does hereby ORDER, in accordance with the provisions of West Virginia Code Chapter 8, Article 6, the following described property formerly situate in Parkersburg District, Wood County, West Virginia, is hereby annexed to the City of Parkersburg:

Beginning at a point in the existing Corporation line of the City of Parkersburg, from which the southerly line of 36th Street bears N. 27-22 E. 7.58 feet; Thence, with the existing corporation line, S. 27-22 W. 241.01 feet to a point which is the easterly projection of the southerly exterior line of a 1-story concrete block building; Thence, with the said easterly

projection of said building line, N. 63-10 W. 53.45 feet to the southeasterly corner of said building; Thence, with the exterior lines of the said 1-story concrete block building, the following courses:
N. 63-10 W. 160.11 feet; Thence,
N. 26-50 E. 20.00 feet; Thence,
N. 63-10 W. 38.00 feet; Thence,
N. 26-50 E. 132.00 feet; Thence,
S. 63-10 E. 38.00 feet; Thence,
N. 26-50 E. 89.00 feet; Thence,
S. 63-10 E. 160.11 feet to the northeasterly corner of the aforementioned 1-story concrete block building; Thence, with the easterly projection of the northerly exterior line of the said building S. 63-10 E. 55.66 feet to the beginning, containing 1.303 acres.

A plat of said annexation is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

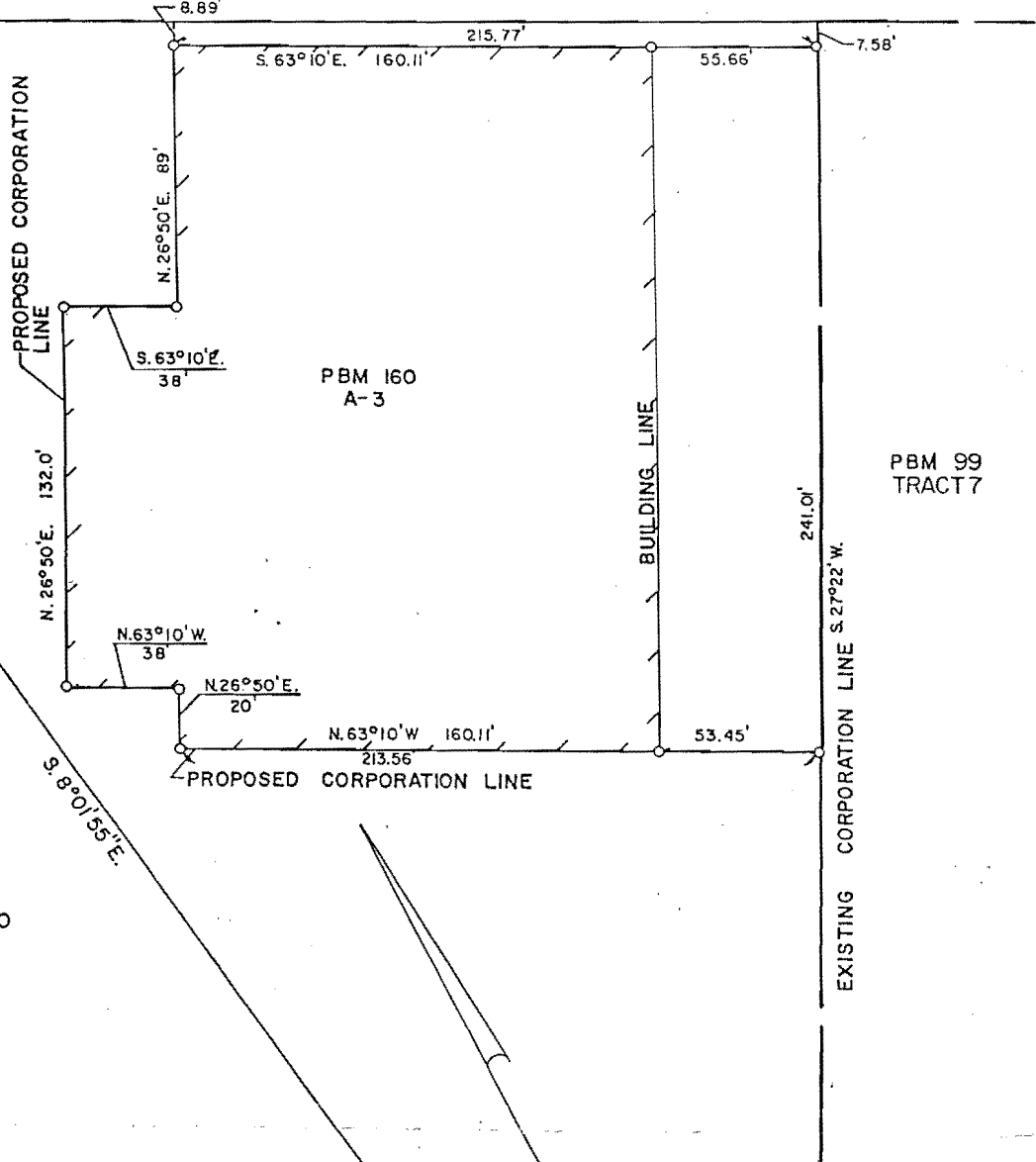
