ORDER

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On the ______ day of March, 1986, came the City of Parkersburg, by James W. Simonton, City Attorney, and also came the freeholder, by Orville L. Hardman, whereupon the parties represented to the Commission that a corrected description of the property to be annexed by the City of Parkersburg had been agreed upon, and that the property which was agreed upon by the City and freeholders to be intended to be encompassed within the original application, is within the confines of the original description contained in the Resolution adopted by the Council of the City of Parkersburg, and subsequently published as part of a legal notice.

The freeholders thereupon advise the Commission that they withdraw their objection to the annexation.

Upon consideration of all of which the Commission does hereby ORDER, in accordance with the provisions of West Virginia Code Chapter 8, Article 6, the following described property formerly situate in Parkersburg District, Wood County, West Virginia, is hereby annexed to the City of Parkersburg:

projection of said building line, N. 63-10 W. 53.45 feet to the southeasterly corner of said building; Thence, with the exterior lines of the said 1-story concrete block building, the following courses:

N. 63-10 W. 160.11 feet; Thence,

N. 26-50 E. 20.00 feet; Thence,

N. 63-10 W. 38.00 feet; Thence,

N. 26-50 E. 132.00 feet; Thence, S. 63-10 E. 38.00 feet; Thence,

N. 26-50 E. 89.00 feet; Thence,


