At 11:25 Prosecuting Attorney, Harry Deitzler, came before the Commission, he appogized on what he said Monday at the Public Hearing, he said that it was misconstrued. He further stated that he was disappointed that his hard working employees were not getting the same raises as the other offices.

At 11:30 Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, Cheryl Millenger came before the Commission to express her impression of the

work load in the office and although she has only been employed for one month she compared the work load to that of Washington County in Ohio where she was previously employed. Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. thanked her for the letter she sent advising the Commission on the situation concerning the County Clerk, H. K. Smith's legal fees.


