At 9:00 Daily business was taken care of by the signing of Purchase Orders and Personal Property Exonerations.

At 9:20 the Commission witnessed the swearing in of Mildred Ingram as a Reserve Deputy. Ms. Ingram is replacing Gene Wilder, who resigned.

At 9:25 the Commission met with Lyndall Jones to discuss the West Virginia University Extension Office's Budget for the fiscal year 1986/1987. President, Holmes R. Shaver stated that the Commission felt it was a good program and they did the best they could. Lyndall Jones stated that he appreciated the job the Commission had done on the Budget. The Extension Office would be a model for the Country.

At 9:35 the Commission went into executive session with County Clerk, H. K. Smith to discuss personnel matters concerning his budget. The meeting ended at 10:23.

At 10:24 the Commission met with the Clerk of Circuit Court, Juanita Coe, to discuss her office's budget.

At 10:38 the Commission met with Prosecuting Attorney Harry Deitzler and Denise Shuck to discuss the Prosecuting Attorney's Office Budget. Harry Dietzler stated that he had a meeting with the Judges and was informed that they would not tolerate the Assistant Attorneys not appearing for their cases. He further stated that the Assistant Prosecuting Attorney line-item was not

sufficient and asked the Commission to reconsider that line-item.


County Assessor Eugene Knotts met with the Commission to discuss the Assessor's Office Budget. Mr. Knotts expressed his disappointment in the salary line-item. At that time he gave the resignation of Vickie Richards to the Commission he referred to the letter and stated that the reason of Ms. Richards resignation was due to the salary. Mr. Knotts asked the Commission to look at the extra-help line item, and the Record books line-item.

At 11:30 the Commission met with Sheriff Greiner, Chief Hoffman and Chief Tax Deputy, Diana Joachim to discuss the Law Enforcement Budget. President, Holmes R. Shaver, pointed out the Radio was budgeted for and three patrol cars. The Sheriff stated that he was dissatisfied with the Salary line-item. The Sheriff was concerend that their was not enough in the Salary line-item to give a raise to all the Correctional Officers and his Chief.

When the Sheriff discussed the Tax Office Budget he expressed the same concern with his Chief Tax Deputy salary. The meeting ended at 12:25.
