At 10:00 the Commission met with Glen Morris to discuss the condition of Forrest Hills Road, Route 50 East. Mr. Morris complained of the road being terrible dusty and asked the Commission if they could give them someone whom he could contact to see if the dust could be controlled. President, Holmes R. Shaver gave him the local representative of the Department of Highways, Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. stated that this was the states responsibility, the county has no equipment for road work.

The Commission signed Purchase Orders, Invoices and two Personal Property Improvers.

Attorney Joe Brown met with the Commission to have the Commission approve an Executive in a will for William Pete Butcher.

At 2:05 Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn arrived.

The Commission signed two letters addressed to the finance department. The first, concerned the transfer of \$9,164.90 from Contracted Services to Court Costs and Damages, for final payment to Attorney Robert M. Bastress. The second letter concerned the issuance of a check in the amount of \$68,000 made payable to the Wood County Parks and Recreation from Entitlement 17 Revenue Sharing.

At 3:00 Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver left for a meeting in Columbus.




This day came the Petitioners by counsel and tendered

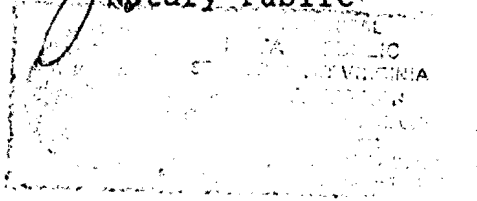
