The Commission held a Public Hearing on the Central-Boaz Reduction, Union-Williams Enlargement. The Hearing began at 10:00, Mr. Hayhurst presented the copies of the Legal Ad and Notice of Posting. Mr. Hayhurst is representing both Union-Williams PSD and Central-Boaz PSD, in this matter of transferring a small portion of land from Central-Boaz to Union Williams. The portion is located at Dry-Run Road and Route 14. This will give Union-Williams about 40 to 50 new users. There was a study done to prove this enlargement would serve the people best. Annabel Delong, Manager of the Union-Williams PSD, Howard Suefer, Board Member, and Neil Vee, Manager of the Central-Boaz PSD were in attendance at this meeting. There was no people in attendance to protest or to speak for the adjustment. The County Commission granted the adjustment upon a motion made by Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. and seconded by Commissioner, Lewis E. Guinn and made unanimous by President, Holmes R. Shaver. The Commission signed Exonerations and Personal Property Impropers.

At 10:30 the Commisstion met with the Sheriff and Chief Hoffman to discuss the billing procedures, and the Sheriff's outstanding invoices. The Commission said that they would look into the problem. The meeting ended at 10:55.

The Commission met with Judge Handlan and Prosecuting Attorney, Harry Deitzler at 11:30.
