IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD MONDAY,
SEPTEMBER 8, 1986

The Commission held a Public Hearing on the Closing of Hyland Drive and Garvey Drive. Leo Lichello filed with the Commission a return of service and the posted notice. The streets that are to be closed are located on North End and Sayre Avenue. Mr. Lowden is the abutting property owner. President, Holmes R. Shaver asked if there was anyone present that objected to the closing of the streets, no one was heard. A motion was made by Commissioner, Lewis E. Guinn and seconded by Commissioner, Dexter L. Buckley, Jr. and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver that the streets be closed. The Commission accepted the order. The hearing ended at 9:35.

This morning Snowden Kesterson, Joe Banasik, and Ray Dowes came before the Commission. Snowden Kesterson read a letter concerning the Governor's Executive Order on the Prison. Mr. Kesterson stated that Harry Deitzler was not doing his job as President of the Prosecuting Attorney's Association. Mr. Kesterson read another letter addressed to the Wood County Commission requesting that Harry Dietzler put a suit against Cole-Layer-Trumble Copmany, he stated that this would relieve the Commission of their duty of hearing those thousands of petitions. He stated further that Harry Deitzler would not represent the school board which is his duty. Joe Banasik gave the Commission a copy of his constitution he told the Commission that all officials should have a copy of it.

The Commission left to inspect the Magistrate Building for the use of the Western District Guidance Center for an inibrated center.

The Commission signed a letter and Order in regard to the Commission wishing to place the Fire Fee Proposal on the ballot for the General Election in November. A copy of the letter and Order is attached.


The Commission signed an Order in regard to Marvin Dowler presenting a completed surbey of the Orphan Roads in Wood County. A copy of the Order is attached.


