President, Shaver asked Mr. Kesterson if he objected on the lack of good government in Vienna. Snowden Kesterson stated that he objected because of the organization of the Southern part of Vienna. President, Holmes R. Shaver stated that Snowden Kesterson's objection did not adequately cover this petition. The Commission agreed that the annexation be granted. The Order will be filed today. The hearing ended at 10:13.

At 10:30 Evelyn Anderson came before the Commission in regard to her giving an easement on her property and property was damaged beyond the easement. She filed a complaint with the Mineral Wells Public Service District. The Anderson's went to Attorney Bill White, he informed them their only alternative was to file a law suit, but they would probably not win. Mr. Radebaugh had taken a tour of the property and told the contractor not to damage the property. Mrs. Anderson stated that three walnut trees were destroyed and trash was left. President Shaver stated that the Commission would get in touch with Bruce White and discuss the situation and then get back with her.

At 11:00 the Commission held a sealed bid opening for a car to be leased for the Emergency Services. The Commission received one bid from McClinton Chevrolet for a 1987 Chevrolet Celebrity with 36 monthly payments of \$236.36. The initial money required first months payments of \$236.36 and a security deposit of \$300.00 plus \$40.00 for tax and title, the total amount is \$609.36. The Commission will take the bids underadvisement. A copy of the Order and bid is attached.

Judge Handlan introduced the new Law Master Joseph Waters to the Commission.
