SEPTEMBER 25, 1986

At 9:00 this morning the Commission held an Alleged
Incompetency Hearing for Gertrude Lang Lynde. Attorney Beth Pyles
Guardian Ad Litem for Mrs. Lynde was sworn in by Deputy Clerk
Jean Campbell. President Holmes R. Shaver stated that the Commission
had the answer from the Guardian ad litem, Beth Pyles and asked if
she wished to add any comments. Mrs. Pyles stated that she had
visited Mrs. Lynde yesterday and found that Mrs. Lynde was bed-
ridden and was unable to care for herself. Mrs. Pyles left the
hearing. The Attorney Bill Critten stated that Dr. Bice was Mrs.
Lynde's attending physician. Mr. Nelson Marcus Lynde was sworn
in by Deputy Clerk Jean Campbell. Mr. Lynde has been married to
Mrs. Lynde for 57 years. Mrs. Lynde is 83 years of age. She is
suffering from Alzheimers disease and arthritis. She resides at
43 Oakwood Estates. She has been bed fast since January 19, 1986,
she is unable to care for herself. She is unable to tend to her
business. Upon the testimony of Mr. Lynde and the Guardian ad litem
Beth Pyles, and the affidavit from Dr. Bice, Commissioner Dexter L.
Buckley, Jr. made the motion seconded by Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn
and made unanimous by Commission President, Holmes R. Shaver that
Mrs. Lynde be declared incompetent. The Commission then considered
Committee for Mrs. Lynde. Mrs. Lynde's only income is Social
Security. All other assets are listed in Mr. Lynde's name.

President Holmes R. Shaver stated that a property bond would be the easiest to post. President Shaver asked if there was anyone present that desired to be appointed as Committee for Mrs. Lynde. No one was heard. Commissioner Lewis E. Guinn made the motion and Commissioner Dexter L. Buckley, Jr., seconded and Commission President Holmes R. Shaver made it unanimous that Mr. Nelson Lynde be appointed as Committee for Mrs. Gertrude Lang Lynde. A property bond in the amount of \$50,000 will be posted. An order will be filed today.


The Commission signed Purchase Orders and Invoices. Then the Commission began the reappraisal hearings scheduled for today.
