The Commission met in regular session on this date. They signed purchase orders, invoices, one improper and correspondence.

At 10:00 A.M. Patrick Wolford was sworn in as a new Correctional Officer.

Mary R. Rader, Wood County Planning Commission Director, met with the Commission on this date to present a plat of the redivision of a 1.48 acre tract owned by Robert A. Pryce. Said 1.48 acre tract is a part of Oakbrook Addition, Section "B". Said plat has been redivided into a 0.662 acre lot, a 0.456 acre lot and a 0.351 acre lot. These lots will be governed and restricted the same as the original 1.48 acre tract. Oakbrook Addition, Section "B" is located in Slate District. The Commission gave approval to the plat of the redivision. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The Commission received a letter from Community Bank on this date correcting the name of the security pledged on Order dated April 6, 1989. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the Commission gave authorization to One Valley Bank, Charleston, WV, to pay \$5,000.00 for Bond No. R-14871. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The Commission authorized President Guinn to sign the 1989 Governor's Summer Youth Program Request for Positions. The County Commission has requested 76 summer youth enrollees and 6 supervisors to provide services to 13 worksites for a period of 6 weeks. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further business or scheduled appointments, the Commission adjourned at 12 o'clock noon.
