On this date, the Commission entered into a Consultation Agreement with Richard L. Rogers regarding the Grants. An Order was prepared concerning this matter.


On this date, the Commission authorized President Guinn to sign the partial release of Lot #115 of the Mullenix Subdivision. An Order was prepared concerning this matter.
