IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD THURSDAY,
DECEMBER 21, 1989

The County Commission met in regular session on this date. The Commission signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

At 9:00 a.m. the Commission met with County Administrator, Mary Rader, to discuss various office procedures.

At 10:24 a.m. the Commission held an incompetency hearing for William Sloane, the Attorney was David Sanders. Denise Cottrill Smith, a Social Worker for St. Joesph Hospital, testified that she was acquainted with William Sloane and that based on his social history he has no family. He is approximately 70 years of age and has cerebral palsy and is deaf. Commissioner Grimm made the motion to declare William Sloane incompetent, seconded by Commissioner Shaver and made unanimous by Commission President Guinn. In order for him to be admitted to a nursing home he needs someone with his power of attorney and they recommended the Sheriff of Wood County be appointed as Committee. Mr. Sloane has an account in his name and Sammy Burdette from the Sheltered Workshop. He is not collecting Social Security because he has no payee. Commissioner Grimm moved that the Sheriff of Wood County be appointed as Committee for William Sloane and Commissioner Shaver seconded and Commission President Guinn made it unainmous. The hearing ended at 10:30 a.m. The file is in the Probate Office.

At 10:30 a.m. the Commission met with the Jamie Six in regard to a desk top tape system for his offices priced at \$5700. The Commission was advised to go out to bid for this system. The bid opening is scheduled for January 11, 1990. An Order was prepared for this matter.

President Guinn signed the application for the deputies annual in-service training. An Order was prepared for this matter.


Having no other scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the Commission adjourned at noon.


