The Commission met in regular session on this date and signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

Jerry Graham was sworn in as a Correctional Officer and James Day was sworn in as an Administrative Assistant to the County Clerk.

At 9:30 A.M. Dominic Kim, Architect; Margaret Monroe, Magistrate; Ira Atkinson, Magistrate; Emily Bradley, Magistrate; and Joyce Purkey, Magistrate Clerk met with the Commission to discuss plans for the Magistrate Court Building.

At 10:00 A.M. the Commission had a hearing regarding Michael Harley Montgomery, alleged incompetent. Those present were: Karen Schimmel, Dave Underwood, Guardian Ad Litem, and Mr. and Mrs. Montgomery. Michael Montgomery resides at Colin Anderson Center. The Commission declared Michael Montgomery incompetent. There will be approximately \$354.00 per month SSI for Michael Montgomery and that is the only asset. Hearing no objection the Commission appointed Thomas and Patricia Montgomery Committee.

Commissioner Steven A. Grimm signed the Monthly Financial Report and the Request for Reimbursement Forms for Grant No. DFC-87-011. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

President Lewis E. Guinn signed the Monthly Financial Report No. 5 and the Request for Reimbursement Forms for Grant No. DLE-016. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


At 11:00 A.M. the Commission held a hearing for Eulah Geraldine Horner, alleged incompetent. Those present: Joseph McFarland, Attorney; William Crichton V, Guardian Ad Litem and Mrs. Horner's two daughters. Mrs. Horner is unable to speak and uses sign language. She resides with one daughter, Mary Ann McCartney, at 3205 Broad Street, Parkersburg, WV. Mrs. McCartney handles all of Mrs. Horner's needs. Mrs. Horner is unable to dress herself or to take care of her daily needs. She cannot handle her financial or business needs. The Commission declared Eulah Geraldine Horner incompetent. Hearing no objections, the Commission appointed Mary Ann McCartney Committee for Eulah Geraldine Horner. A corporate surety bond was set for \$10,000.00.

Having no further business or scheduled appointments, the Commission adjourned at 12:00 o'clock noon.
