IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD MONDAY, JANUARY 30, 1989

At 9:00 A.M. Bill Gibbs met with the Commission to discuss software programs for the Sheriff's Tax Office.

The Commission signed purchase orders and correspondence this date.

At 10:00 A.M. the Commission held a hearing for Glada J. Pavelish, Alleged Incompetent. Those attending were: Diana Everett, Attorney; Paula Wiles, daughter; David Anthony Pavelish, son; and Patrick McFarland, Guardian Ad Litem. Glada J. Pavelish is a resident of Weston State Hospital since late 1988 as a result of a Mental Hygiene Hearing through the Circuit Court. Mrs. Pavelish is unable to take care of her physical, business or financial needs. Paula Wiles, David Anthony Pavelish and Patrick McFarland were sworn in. There is an Affidavit from Kamal A. Nizami, M.D. Steven A. Grimm made the motion, Holmes R. Shaver seconded and Lewis E. Guinn made it unanimous to declare Glada J. Pavelish Incompetent.

Glada J. Pavelish's only apparent income is around \$400.00 per month alimony. She has a trailer. Hearing no objections, the Commission appointed Paula Wiles Committee for Glada J. Pavelish. Other pertinent information is on file in the Circuit Clerk's Office. A \$5,000.00 corporate surety bond was set.


The Commission accepted and allowed the purchase of the various equipment for use by the Sheriff's Department through a Drug Law Enforcement Grant, State of West Virginia, pursuant to bid opening on January 5, 1989. An Order was prepared for this matter.

Steven A. Grimm and Holmes R. Shaver sat as a Board of Canvassers to oversee the canvass of the Special Levy election for the School Board on this date.


Having no further business or scheduled appointments, the Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
