The Commission met in regular session on this date. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence on this date.

At 9:30 A.M. the Commission met with Ishmael Johnson, Robert Morgan and Hans Morgan regarding building codes for the County.

At 10:00 A.M. the Commission had a hearing for Henry Carter Byrd, alleged incompetent. Those attending were: Joe Albright, Attorney, Donna Mae Lockhart, Earl Franklin Lockhart, and Gerald Townsend, Guardian ad Litem. Mr. Byrd resides in a nursing home in Jackson County, West Virginia. He is bedfast, cannot communicate and cannot care for his personal or business needs. His wife (Mary Margaret Byrd) passed away January 13, 1989. There were no children. There is an Affidavit from John Michael Foster, M.D. and an Affidavit from Samuel Johnson, M.D. The Commission declared Henry Carter Byrd incompetent. Earl Franklin Lockhart resides in Apartment 105 at Unity Plaza, Parkersburg, WV. Mr. Lockhart stated that the assets for the Byrds are approximately \$50,000.00. Hearing no objections, the Commission appointed Earl Franklin Lockhart Committee for Henry Carter Byrd. Mr. Lockhart was also appointed administrator of the estate of Mary Margaret Byrd. A corporate surety bond of \$50,000.00 is to be posted.

At 11:00 A.M. Jack Casto met with the Commission. He discussed right-of-ways for Claywood Park.

At 1:30 P.M. Mary Rader and Vickie Johnson met with the Commission to discuss office procedures.


